


Fig-1: Organogram of Pathao Ltd.




Fig-2: SWOT Analysis of Pathao Limited

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


Fig-3: PESTEL Analysis of Pathao Ltd.

This shift underscores the dynamic nature of the industry, with competitors vying for dominance and pushing each other to innovate. As a result, the third-generation courier sector is experiencing heightened competition and growth potential, making it an increasingly captivating arena to watch.

Pathao's ventures extend far beyond the realm of Courier/Logistics, demonstrating a diversified approach across multiple industries. Notably, Pathao Food, Pathao bike/car, and Pathao Pay represent the company's strategic foothold in food delivery, ride-sharing, and fin-tech sectors,





respectively. However, within the competitive food delivery landscape, Pathao encounters a significant challenge posed by dominant players like Food Panda, who command a substantial market share, necessitating strategic maneuvers to secure a leading position.

In the ride-sharing arena, Pathao enjoys prominence in the bike specification segment, yet faces stiff competition from Uber, the market leader in car specifications. This rivalry intensifies as other players like In-drive, Shuttle, and Obhai enter the fray, underscoring the highly competitive nature of the industry. While Pathao strives to maintain its foothold and expand its market share, the battle for supremacy against established giants remains fierce.

Transitioning to the fin-tech sector, Pathao Pay enters a highly competitive landscape dominated by industry leaders like Bkash and Nagad, who collectively command a significant market share. Despite the presence of other fintech players like Upay and Rocket, Pathao Pay endeavors to carve out its niche by refining its interface, financial systems, and features to enhance market penetration and competitiveness. This uphill battle highlights the company's resilience and determination to establish itself as a formidable player in diverse sectors beyond its courier operations.

Moreover, transparent communication channels and regular performance evaluations can further reinforce accountability, allowing for timely feedback and corrective actions as needed. Ultimately, by enhancing accountability within its operations, Pathao Courier can optimize efficiency, enhance customer satisfaction, and maintain the position as a leader in the on-demand delivery market.

• Implementing Smart access to data to optimize the overall logistics
