IUT CONVOCAATION

At the end of Academic Year 2015-16, the 30th Convocation of IUT was held on 8 December 2016 on its campus at Board Bazar, Gazipur. H.E. Mr. Nurul Islam Nahid, MP, Minister for Education, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. H.E. Ambassador Muhammad Naeem Khan, Asstt. Secretary General, OIC attended the convocation as the representative of H.E. Dr. Yousef bin Ahmad Al-Othaimeen, Secretary General of the OIC and Chancellor of IUT. H.E. Dr. Mohammad S. Alalam Alzahrani, Chairman, Governing Board, IUT was also present. More than 300 distinguished guests attended the convocation ceremony.
